

**THE MUNICIPALITY OF GRAND LAKE (MGL)**  
**BY-LAW NO. 03-01**  
**A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE REMUNERATION OF COUNCIL FOR**  
**THE MUNICIPALITY OF GRAND LAKE**

**PURPOSE:** A By-law of The Municipality of Grand Lake, in the Province of New Brunswick, for the purpose of establishing the remuneration of the council for The Municipality of Grand Lake.

**BE IT ENACTED:** Pursuant to subsection 49(1) of the *Local Governance Act*, the Council of the Municipality of Grand Lake adopts as follows:

**1. REMUNERATION OF THE COUNCIL**

1.01 The mayor shall be paid an annual salary of \$35,000.00; the amount being payable in equal monthly instalments.

1.02 The deputy mayor shall be paid an annual salary of \$17,500.00; the amounts being payable in equal monthly instalments.

1.03 Each councilor shall be paid an annual salary of \$14,000.00, the amounts being payable in equal monthly instalments.

1.04 The councilor at large shall be paid an additional annual salary of \$3,500.00 on top of the base councilor salary of \$14,000.00; the amounts being payable in equal monthly instalments.

**2. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This By-law comes into effect on third reading and enactment.


**3. REPEAL**

The enactment of this by-law repeals the following by-law: The Municipality of Grand Lake By-Law No. 03 a By-Law respecting the remuneration of Council for the Municipality of Grand Lake, given under the hands of the Transition Facilitator on December 13, 2022.

Village of Minto By-law No. 138 A by-law Regulating the Proceedings of Council AND  
Village of Chipman By-law No. 87 A by-law Respecting Renumeration of the Mayor and Councillors

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Minister of Local Government and Local Governance Reform as follows:

**1. REMUNERATION OF THE COUNCIL**

1.01 The mayor shall be paid an annual salary of \$35,000; the amount being payable in equal instalments.

1.02 The deputy mayor shall be paid an annual salary of \$17,500; the amounts being payable in equal instalments.

1.03 Each councilor shall be paid an annual salary of \$14,000, the amounts being payable in equal instalments.
