PURPOSE: A By-law of The Municipality of Grand Lake, in the Province of New Brunswick, for the purpose of establishing the remuneration of the council for The Municipality of Grand Lake.

BE IT ENACTED: Pursuant to subsection 49(1) of the *Local Governance Act*, the Council of the Municipality of Grand Lake adopts as follows:

1. REMUNERATION OF THE COUNCIL

- 1.01 The mayor shall be paid an annual salary of \$35,000.00; the amount being payable in equal monthly instalments.
- 1.02 The deputy mayor shall be paid an annual salary of \$17,500.00; the amounts being payable in equal monthly instalments.
- 1.03 Each councilor shall be paid an annual salary of \$14,000.00, the amounts being payable in equal monthly instalments.
- 1.04 The councilor at large shall be paid an additional annual salary of \$3,500.00 on top of the base councilor salary of \$14,000.00; the amounts being payable in equal monthly instalments.

2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This By-law comes into effect on third reading and enactment.

3. REPEAL

The enactment of this by-law repeals the following by-law: The Municipality of Grand Lake By-Law No. 03 a By-Law respecting the remuneration of Council for the Municipality of Grand Lake, given under the hands of the Transition Facilitator on December 13, 2022.
